





This breakout will overview a biblical theology of "sight" by showing how the Bible often uses sight/seeing as a symbol that has great significance for a biblical worldview.






## Who are Gen Z and what do they believe?

- Gen Z (born 1997–2012) is the least religious generation. Almost half of Gen Z in the United States describe themselves as "nones" (having no religious beliefs).
- Gen Z are also experiencing a mental-health crisis with higher rates of anxiety and depression than any previous generation.
- Gen Z are spiritually hungry. Many forms of spirituality are being pursued on TikTok and elsewhere, and Gen Z still pray at least occasionally.
- Gen Z are also seeking Christ. A survey among University of Kentucky students found 75 percent would accept an invitation to church. The Asbury Awakening and other students' movements also reveal that a hunger for God is bubbling up.

## Reaching Gen Z on TikTok and social media:

- TikTok has more than 1 billion monthly users, half of whom are Gen Z (under the age of 30).
- TikTok (and social media in general) can be detrimental but is also a new mission field for sowing seeds for the Gospel.
- TikTok principles for sharing your faith Capture attention. Be creative. Speak their language. Point to Jesus.
- TikTok videos that went viral "Evidence for God," "Science and Faith," "The Evidence for Jesus"
